**Silver Spring, MD – August 23, 2010** – Over sixty book artists and contemporary printmakers will exhibit, present, demonstrate and install their art during the eleventh biennial Book Arts Conference and Fair, hosted by Pyramid Atlantic in the new Silver Spring Civic Building.

Participating artists hail from across the U.S. and around the globe, including England and China. Exhibitors will vie for the opportunity to win awards based on artistic excellence. In addition to purchase, award winners receive recognition at the show and an invitation to the following year's show.
